Mr. HERMANN, from the Select Committee on Indian Depredation Claims, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 655.]

The Select Committee on Indian Depredation Claims, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 655) for the relief of P. C. Davis, submit the following report:

We find that claimant while in Oregon in 1878 was the owner of certain property there of the value of \$600, and that the same was taken away and destroyed by the Pi-Utes and Bannock Indians during the hostilities of said year; that the Interior Department recommended payment of the same, and found said sum due.

We therefore recommend payment of the said sum of \$600.
