Mr. BLISS, from the Committee on Pensions, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany bill H. R. 10558.]

The Committee on Pensions, to whom was referred the bill (H. R. 10558) granting a pension to Lankford Pugh, have considered the same and report as follows:

The claimant served in Capt. Dennis Dent's company, Alabama Volunteers, Indian war, from February 27 to May 27, 1836, a period of three months. He is now seventy-four years old and in very needy circumstances, with a wife nearly as old depending upon his labor.

He is entitled to a service pension for his military services rendered fifty years ago. Your committee recommend the passage of the bill.
