REPORT:

The Committee on Military Affairs, to whom was referred the resolution of the House, that the Secretaries of War and of the Interior be requested to send to the House all official statements and correspondence in their possession, or that of their subordinates, relating to the arrest and killing of Sitting Bull, especially the reports of those officers and agents directly concerned in ordering or effecting the arrest of said Sitting Bull, together with all other papers or facts known to them in connection with said matter, report that the committee have considered the same, and report it back to the House and recommend that it do pass.
