A schedule of Indian depredation claims which have been investigated pursuant to the Indian appropriation bill for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1890.

FEBRUARY 25, 1891.—Referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs.

Washington, February 25, 1891.

SIR: In compliance with the provisions contained in the act of March 2, 1889 (25 Stat., 998), making appropriations for the Indian Service for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1890, I have the honor to transmit herewith a schedule of Indian depredation claims which have been investigated pursuant to said act.

These claims comprise those finally considered and determined since the date of the report of January 15, 1890, submitting a prior schedule of such claims, which will be found printed in House Ex. Doc. 122, Fifty-first Congress, first session.

The letter of the Commissioner of Indian Affairs, dated 24th instant, to this Department on the subject, is herewith inclosed.

ing treaty relations with the Government, which have been investigated pursuant to said act.

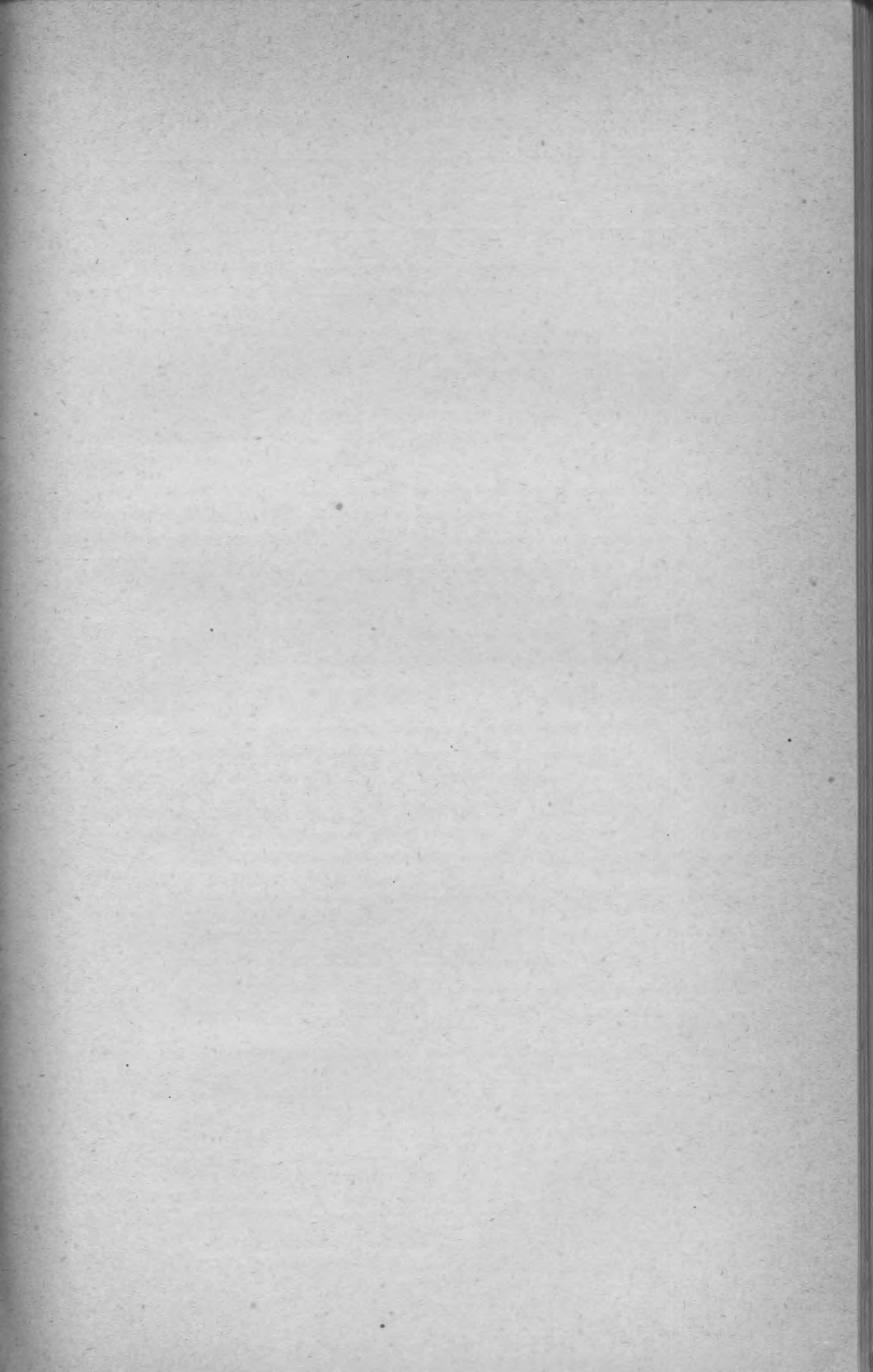

Accompanying each claim herewith is the record of the testimony presented and all former action had, together with a letter embodying office "opinions and conclusions upon all material facts, and all the evidence and papers pertaining thereto.
