> GENERAL LAND OFFICE, March 9, 1838.

SIR: Pursuant to the resolution of the Senate of the United States, passed on the 3d instant, in the words following:

"Resolved, That the Secretary of the Treasury be instructed to report

to the Senate, as follows: "1. The whole number of acres of land that have been granted to the

State of Indiana, for all purposes. "2. The number of acres of land that were granted to the State of Indiana under the provisions of the act of 2d March, 1827, confirming the provisions of the second article of the treaty of the 16th October, 1826, between the commissioners of the United States and the Pottawatamie tribe of Indians.

"3. The number of acres of land that were granted to the State of Indiana under the provisions of the act of 2d March, 1827, as the same have been located.

"4. What portion of the lands granted to the State of Indiana by the of the 2d March, 1827, lie in the State of Ohio, and have been received that State."
