RESOLUTION:

Resolved by the Senate of the United States, That the Secretary of the Interior be, and he is hereby, directed to report to the Senate, as early spossible, the result of any investigations that he may have completed inder the direction of that provision of the act "making appropriations for sundry civil expenses of the government for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, eighteen hundred and eighty-three, and for other purposes," relating to any dispute between the Cherokee Indians or any part or band thereof and the United States, "arising from or growing out of treaty stipulations or the laws of Congress relating thereto."
