Mr. Allison, from the Committee on Indian Affairs, reported the following

## RESOLUTION:

Resolved, That a select committee of five Senators be appointed to examine into the circumstances connected with the removal of the Northern Cheyennes from the Sioux Reservation to the Indian Territory, their treatment whilst in the Territory, their escape therefrom, and all the circumstances connected therewith; and also to examine into the facts attending their arrest or capture after such escape, their confinement, disarmament, escape, subsequent slaughter, and recapture.

That said committee shall have power to send for persons and papers, examine witnesses under oath, employ a clerk and stenographer, and sit during the recess of the Senate and at such times and places as the committee may determine, and shall report their proceedings to Congress at its next session.
