REPORT:

[To accompany bill S. 920.]

The Committee on Military Affairs, to whom was referred the bill (S. 920) "to confer brevet promotion on officers of the United States Army particularly distinguished by heroic action in Indian warfare, and for other purposes," having acted on the same subject-matter, report this bill back adversely, and recommend that its consideration be indefinitely postponed.
