Ambassador Silent Auction at the OHCE State Meeting 2014 Declared A Success!

Monday, July 14th was a great day for the CE-FCS Ambassadors! A heartfelt thank you goes to everyone's cooperation in preparing, hosting, implementing, and donating toward the Silent Auction. We had great donors, bidders and volunteers! There was a total of fifty-three donated items for the auction representing forty Oklahoma counties (plus additional individuals' donations) as well as twenty additional counties making monetary contributions in lieu of baskets. In total, the 2014 Silent Auction raised **\$4,256.96**!

If checks were written to the OSU Foundation, auction proceeds were able to be divided evenly between Ambassadors and the Margaret Edsel Fitch Fellowship funds. These funds go to a great cause – applied toward projects, many of which are new or innovative, that fit the creed of OHCE and the mission of the OCES Family and Consumer Sciences and 4-H.
