BECHTEL MOTIONS FOR A NEW TRIAL

The following excerpts were taken from the Motion For a New Trial for Donna Bechtel．

1．The refusal of the trial court to permit Dr．Lenore Walker（ an expert on the batter－ ed woman＇s syndrome）to testify as an expert witness to assist the trier of fact concern－ ing the fact that Donna Bechte 1 was a bat－ tered woman，and explain how she came to be a battered woman，why she stayed with Ken－ neth Bechtel，and her state of mind at the time the acts occurred which give rise to these charges denied Donna Bechtel a fair trial．
2．The refusal of the trial couri to in－ struct the jury on the burden of proof con－ cerning self－defense denied the accused a fair trial．
3．The trial court erred when it prohibit－ ed defense counsel from questioning jurors about the burden of proof in self－defense and denied Donna Bechtel a fair trial． 4．Denial of the right to cross－examine witnesses against her denied Donna Bechtel a fair trial．
5．Refusal of the trial court to permit Donna Bechtel to present evidence in ac－ cordance with the Sixth Amendment to the United States Constitution denied her a fair trial．（Police procedures concerning crime scene，conversations with witnesses concerning Kenneth Bechtel）．
6 ．The court repeatedly，during the six days Donna Bechtel was on the witness stand testifying，sustained objections to ques－ tions concerning threats and conversations． 7．The trail court on numerous occasions commented on the evidence in ruling upon objections and in admonitions to defense counsel and this denied the accused a fair trial．
8．Prosecutorial misconduct denied Donna Bechtel a fair trial．
9．Statements to press before and during the trial concerning the case．
10．The trial court＇s refusal to provide Donna Bechtel with a court reporter con－ cerning all communications about this case which is reque

NOTES FROM THE JURY BOX

The Bechtel trial has drawn to a close； she＇s now been sentenced and we have all begun serving our life sentences．By the ＂we＂I mean Ms．Bechtel and each of us that sat in the jury box．

A11 week I＇ve heard various accounts and opinions of the trial．The crucial accounting of the trial is the one I exper－ ienced．It is the one from the＂viewpoint＂ of that jury box．We were drafted and re－ moved from the mainstream of our normal lives．We accepted the responsibility and gave the case our undivided attention．Af－ ter a11，a woman＇s fate rested in our hands．This was a serious matter．

I believe everyone is entitled to a vig－ orous defense and Garvin Issacs certain1y lived up to his reputation in that respect． While his behavior was not above reproach， the rotten apple must be placed on the pro－ secution＇s table．

I will forever remain appalled at the antics and behavior I observed in that courtroom from that jury box．I would ex－ pect unfaltering professional behavior from the District Attorney＇s office since many of us hold that office in a light synony－ mous with the law．At the very least，I would expect the two prosecutors to main－ tain composure and stifle giggles while testimony was being given．Their overall behavior would be more befitting of a schoolgirls＇slumber party than a court of law．Throughout the trial the prosecutors seemed to be afflicted with some＂virus＂ causing uncontrollable eyeball rotation and facial contortions that would suggest each of them had a mouthful of green parsimmons． At times，it would cause them to poke each other and snicker．

I would expect in a＂fair trial＂the ac－ cused would be given the opportunity to re－ late their version to us（the Jury）without being ridiculed or intimidated by gestures made by the prosecutors．I＇m not sure how much of this was visible to the audience， but I do know from my chair it was，at times，so distracting I would have to sit with my left hand covering part of my face to block them out and concentrate on the testimony being given．I wondered at times how Ms．Bechtel could maintain her train of thought while giving her testimony．Testi－ mony on which her fate was hinged．

I would suggest that professional behav－ ior be to listen，and then address any in－ consistencies or questions in the＂cross－

The Gay Pride Week celebration will cap off with＂Zoom Beach＂on Sunday，June 26 at Lake Thunderbird．This is a fun gathering with free beer，pop，and hot dogs．Bring your favorite game or sporting equipment and plan to spend the day in good company．

There are few laws on a national level and fewer still on the state level to pro－ tect or acknowledge lesbian and gay rights． On June 19th Oklahoma gays will exercise the right to peacefully gather in public． It is hoped that all advocates of human rights and civil rights will come out and show their support by participating in the rally and march for gay rights．

HOUSE MEMBERS OPPOSE SEXUAL ORIENTATION
HOUSE MEMBERS OPPOSE GAYS IN HATE CRIMES BILL

WASHINGTON，DC－Representative George Gekas（R－PA）leads the fight to remove sexual orientation from the Hate Crimes Statistics Act（H．R．3193）．This Act would mandate the collection of statis－ tics on crimes that are motivated by pre－ judice based on race，religion，sexual or－ ientation and ethnicity．

The National Gay and Lesbian Task Force （NGLTF）is working to thwart attempts to remove sexual orientation from the legisla－ tion．

Gekas has filed a minority report which asserts that＂It is not a federal obliga－ tion to protect citizens in their sexual orientation＂．Despite a recent Department of Justice study which found gay people to be the most frequent victims of hate vio－ lence today，the Gekas report disputes the prevalance of anti－gay violence．Despite documented evidence of hundreds of instances of organized hate group activity against gay men and lesbians，the minority report asserts that gay people are not the targets of organized hate group activity by groups like the Ku Klux Klan．

To prevent Gekas from succeeding in re－ moving the sexual orientation clause from the Hate Crimes Statistics Act，and there－ by spreading his bigotry toward gays，the NGLTF urges interested persons to write to their representatives today．

## KOWALSKI TO BE TESTED

HIBBING，MN－St．Louis County Judge Robert Campbell ruled recently that Sharon Kowalski should be formally tested for com－ petency，and ordered that her new court－ appointed attorney，Gary Pagliacetti，con－ sult with Duluth－area physicians to select a test site．Kowalski was severely injured in an automobile accident in November 1983. Her lover，Karen Thompson，has been fight－ ing Kowalski＇s anti－gay parents in court for almost four years for the right to see and participate in Kowalski＇s medical care．

Judge Campbell＇s ruling means that Ko－ walski will be tested for the first time since a court order appointed her father guardian three years ago－－an order that required him to have her tested annually．

Pagliacetti told the court that he had visited Kowalski four times，and he be－ lieves that she understands what others say to her and that she can communicate effect－ ively when she desires．He said he feels she could use a computer to improve her communication，and move around in an elec－ tric wheelchair．Pagliacetti was appointed by Judge Campbe11 to be Kowalski＇s attor－ ney．

In response to requests from Thompson＇s attorneys，Campbe11 ordered that no attor－ neys except Pagliacetti be allowed to con－ tact Kowalski＇s evaluators until their re－ port is issued．No date has been set for the testing．He requested that all parties submit to him recommendations for testing parameters．Campbell also requested that both Thompson and the Kowalskis provide him with statements detailing how their attor－ neys＇fees are paid．When the testing is
