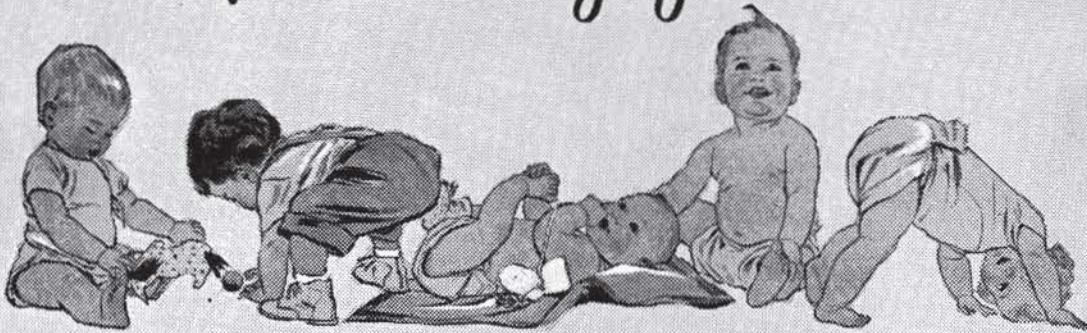

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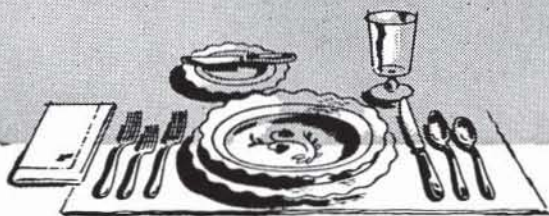

## INDIGENT CLINICS NUMBER TWENTY-EIGHT

Tulsa Council Of Social Agencies Publishes Directory Of Clinic And Welfare Services. Most Clinics Staffed By Volunteer Physicians.

A total of twenty-eight outpatient clinics are now offering specialized medical care and health consultation services to Tulsa indigents, according to a survey published last month by the Health Division of the Tulsa Council of Social Agencies. When the thirteen specialty clinics at the Tulsa County Medical Clinic are included, the total rises to forty-one.

Virtually all of these clinics offer their services without charge to indigents—although the standards by which indigency and eligibility are determined vary greatly from clinic to clinic—while a few do have provisions for pay or part-pay patients. With the exception of a few full-time staff members, all of the medical services are rendered without fee by volunteer physicians from the membership of the Tulsa County Medical Society.

The twenty-eight outpatient clinics listed in the Council's latest Directory of Clinic and Health Conferences are:

Cerebral Palsy Treatment Center, 1434 S. Boulder, for physical therapy of palsied children.

Tulsa Child Guidance Clinic, 602 S. Cheyenne, offering psychiatric attention to children with emotional problems.

Tulsa Club Foot Clinic, St. John's Hospital, rendering diagnostic, therapeutical, and surgical care to club footed children.

Tulsa Dental Clinic, City-County Health Department, offering dental care to indigent children.

Variety Club Heart Clinic, Variety Club Center, consultation and education in heart disease for negro indigents.

Tulsa County Heart Association Diagnostic School Clinic, 1516 S. Quaker, a diagnostic heart clinic for school children.

Heart of the Home Kitchen, 808 S. Peoria, consulting service for cardiacs and for the housewife with physical disabilities.

City-County Health Department Immunization Clinics, 521 N. Boulder, and at scheduled locations throughout the county, for immunization against contagious diseases.

Hillcrest Hospital Maternity Clinic, 1653 E. 12th.

St. John's Hospital Maternity Clinic, 1923 S. Utica.

Variety Club Maternity Clinic, Variety Club Health Center, for negro mothers.

Tulsa County Medical Clinic, 602 S. Cheyenne, general indigent medical care including thirteen specialty clinics in allergy, arthritis, cardiac, dental, dermatology, eye, ear-nose-throat, obstetrics and gynecology, internal medicine, pediatrics, proctology, urology, and varicose.

Moton Hospital Outpatient Clinic, 538 E. Oklahoma, medical care for negro indigents.

Tulsa Orthopedic Clinic, Hillcrest Lying-In Hospital, orthopedic services for children.

# The PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

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*"You Cannot Help Men Permanently By Doing For Them What They Could And Should Do For Themselves" — Lincoln.*

They say sir, that we should improve our public relations (PR), better feeling, understanding, tolerance for one another, and for other groups; industry, law, education, labor, medicine, and politics, all stressing and emphasizing the need for improved P R, and the dividends that are certain to come.

Now if we admit the wisdom of this premise and evaluate on the factors for and against, concluding that the good exceeds the bad, and that as a matter of self improvement, group success, and ultimately happiness for all, I and we will join, but where do I and we or thou begin; As physicians where do we begin! And what can be done to reach this social utopia?

I think that we begin with self inventory of assets and liabilities, then proceed to create the ideal. I fear that in all of us, truth, honesty, and fair dealing has not been our guide. We look to the faults, shortcomings, etc., of everyone else but we never look in the mirror.

Do we grant our fellow physicians the privilege we cherish? Do we speak kindly of him, avoiding disparaging remarks? Do we use our best efforts to see that he is held in high esteem, and that he merits it? Is he given the privilege of modern hospital, laboratory, x-ray, operating rooms, and assistance, or is he denied these, his patients penalized, maybe with their lives, because of ostracism, egotism, and selfishness? Is his application for hospital staff privileges evaluated, and passed on as one friend would another? Or is it "pigeon holed", no answer, or a curt denial with no suggestions as to why, or how the shortcomings might be remedied?

Our P R begins at home. Is it hypocrisy, and fraud to expect the public to believe that we are of the cloth unless we merit and practice same. Can the truth be compromised without expense of honor? Can deception be practiced without self debasement?

If we, my friend, are to have good P R, we must begin with self; more honesty, truth, and fair dealings with one another. Then and only then will we achieve good P R. A brother's keeper must never be a Judas.

Consider the hospital staffs, medical society trustees, delegates, council and vice council, county society committees, are they equal and representative of all physicians, all hospitals? Or do they reflect the practice and operation of the clique? The only clique destined to perpetuity is the American Medical Association, devoid of petty jealousies, equitable in operation, equal opportunity for all, special privilege for none.

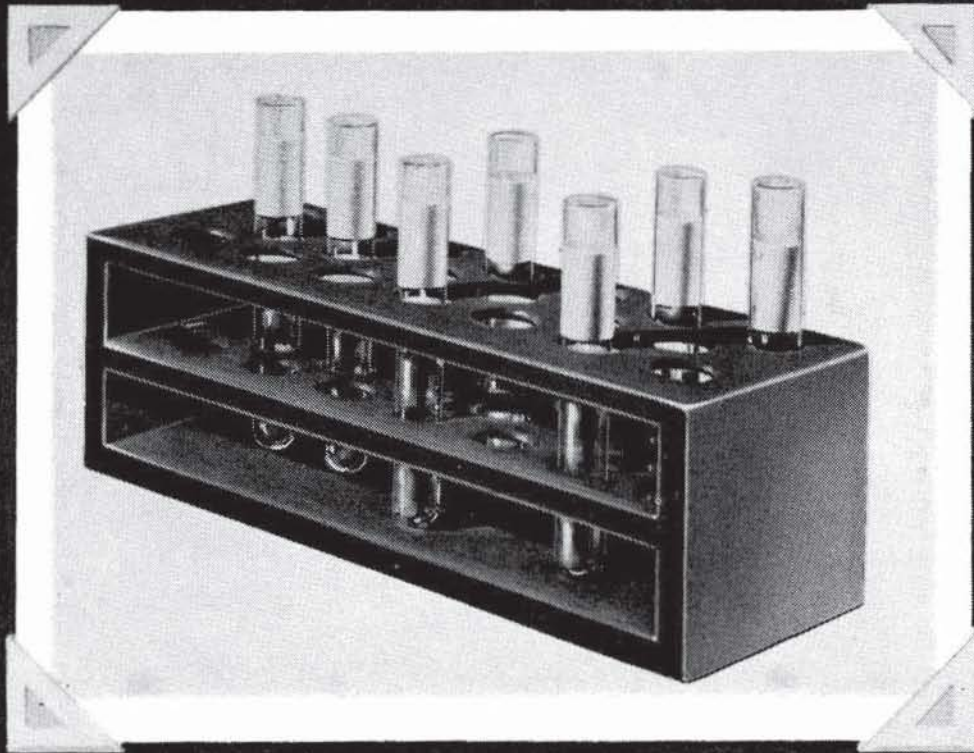

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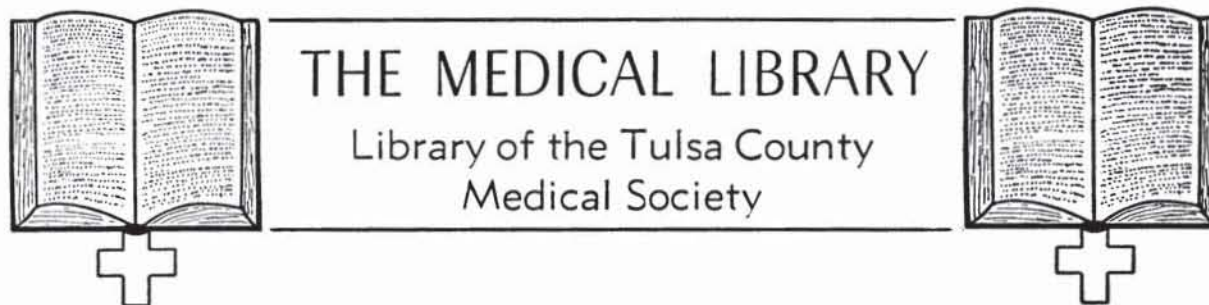

The month of April was not chosen because it showed the largest figures as there have been many months when the grand totals were larger. It was chosen because it was the month just past and because it was fairly representative.



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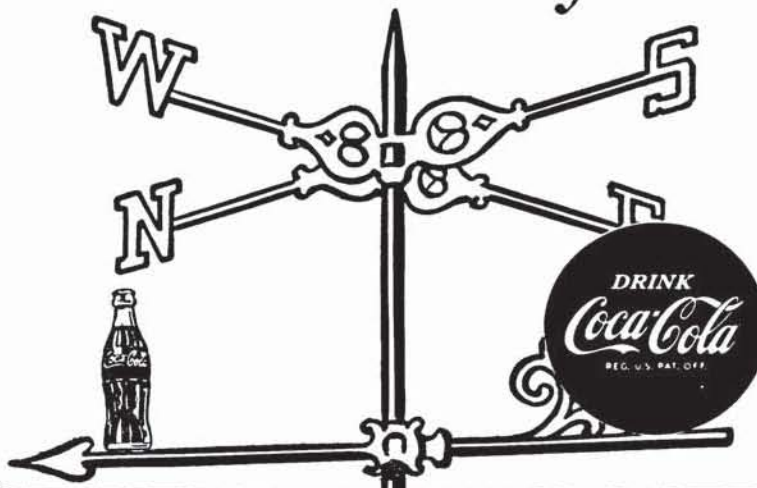

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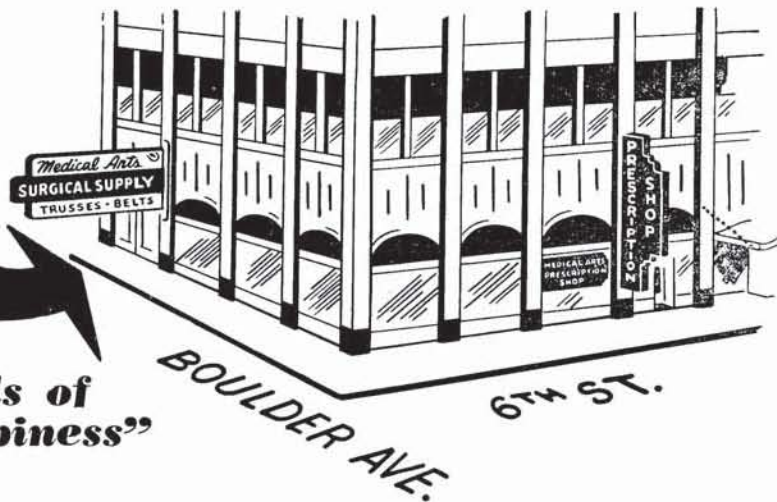


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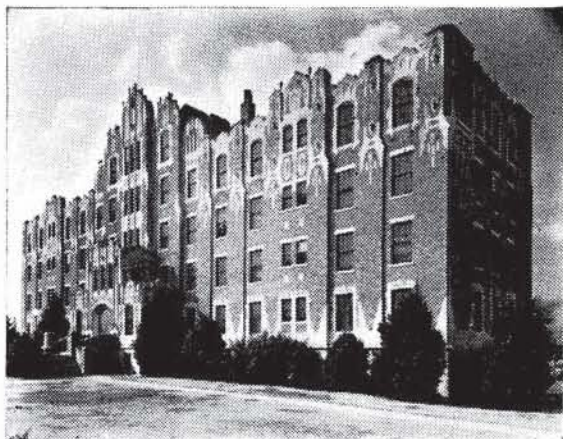
