The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Architect A J Williams presented preliminary drawing for New Science Building.

The Regents upon motion duly seconded and carried authorized Architect to proceed with making of plans & specifications for said building and instructed that limit of cost be not to exceed thirty thousand dollars, including heating, plumbing and wiring equipment and present same for further action of the Regents at their next meeting.

President D. R. Boyd submitted to the Regents a proposal from Mr. Andrew Carnegie of New York to make the University a gift of thirty thousand dollars for the purpose of erecting a Library Building for the University conditioned that the University expend an amount annually equal to ten percentum of the gift in maintaining the University Library.

Regent Gilstrap offered a resolution favoring the acceptance of the gift and the terms of same. The resolution was adopted.
