Mr. SAWYER, from the Committee on Pensions, submitted the following

REPORT:

[To accompany S. 3228.]

The Committee on Pensions, to whom was referred the bill (S. 3228) granting a pension to Typpo S. Williams, have examined the same and report:

The claimant, as shown by the records of the War Department, served as a private in Capt. Holman's company in the Black Hawk war in June, July, and August, 1832, and received an honorable discharge at Dixons Ferry, Ill. The committee have evidence showing that he is now 87 years old, infirm even to helplessness, unable to perform any labor, and dependent upon the charity of the public for home, care, and food.

The bill is reported favorably with a recommendation that it do pass.
